

**NORTHERN VILLAGE OF PINEHOUSE
BYLAW NO. 2-05**

**A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT CHILDREN BEING ON THE STREETS
AFTER CERTAIN HOURS AS SET OUT ON
SCHEDULE "A" OF THIS BYLAW**

The Council of the Northern Village of Pinehouse in the Province of Saskatchewan under the provision of Section 101 of *The Northern Municipalities Act* enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "Curfew Bylaw" of the Northern Village of Pinehouse.
2. No child under the age of fourteen (14) years, or appearing to be under the said age, and lacking definite proof of age, shall be on the streets of the Northern Village of Pinehouse after the hours specified on Schedule "A" of this bylaw and every such child shall be in his or her home after that hour throughout the night.
3. Nothing contained in this bylaw shall apply to a child who is on the streets for some unavoidable cause or who is accompanied by or in charge of a parent or guardian, who is over the age of eighteen (18) years or who is on the streets for the purpose of returning to his or her dwelling for the night.
4. Any child found on the streets or away from his or her home in contravention of the provisions of this bylaw may be warned by the Municipal Curfew Officer or any Police Officer of the community to go home and, if after such warning, such child is loitering on the streets, he or she may be taken by such officer or Police Officer to his or her home of the child. A Notice of Warning in Form "A" will be issued to the parent or guardian.
5. Any parent or guardian who permits a child to contravene the provisions of this bylaw after being warned in writing is guilty of an offence and shall be served with a Notice of Violation in Form B and shall, upon summary conviction be liable to a penalty of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for the first offence and fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each subsequent offence.
6. Previous Curfew Bylaws of the Northern Village of Pinehouse are hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Minister of Government Relations

CURFEW HOURS

A child shall be off the streets within the municipal boundaries of the Northern Village of Pinehouse on the following times and dates:

Sunday to Thursday – on School Days 10:30 pm to 7:00 am

Sunday to Thursday – Non School Days 11:00 pm to 7:00 am

Friday to Saturday..... 11:30 pm to 7:00 am
